Meeting Minutes

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 3:35p.
- 2. Introductions around the room were made.
- 3. Sacramento PD Update

Captain Peletta provided a security update which included:

- 4,236 calls within the District Boundaries were made in 2015
- 666 calls were transient related

Highest accident rate area in the District is the intersection of 19th and Broadway, PD is working on traffic calming and ticketing measures.

Sac PD is currently hiring and 40 new officers just finished the academy. The Department currently has 210 officers; they would like to have 260 on the streets.

- 4. Chair Harrell provided a brief update on the project the students and Cosumnes River College completed relative to identifying infill uses along the Broadway corridor.
- 5. Consuelo Hernandez provided a brief update which included: The City is starting budget discussions and CM Hansen is interested in priorities for GBD. The Right to Rest protest continues with CM Hansen serving on a task force with the County to try and address some of the ongoing issues.
- 6. Director Sacanni provided the GBD balance which is \$158,462 as of December 31, 2015.
- 7. A motion was made to approve the consent calendar with one change. The contract for California Security Agency will be adjusted to require \$1M in coverage for Vehicle/Bodily injury. The motion was made by Director Maxwell, 2nd by Director Reynolds. Motion passed unanimously.

8. Committee Updates

I. Clean and Safe:

Smira-Brattmiller reported out on the meeting that occurred in December. The main action item was that the committee is working with CM Hansen to promote a recycling ordinance in the City of Sacramento.

II. Land Use Committee

Director Maxwell provided a brief update on the most recent land use committee meeting. The Board discussed the draft letter on the Transformation Plan. With edits the letter was approved. Motion was made by Bjork, 2nd by Grimes, Hernandez abstained, motion passed.
